3.1.6 *Number of Teachers*

Lahore district has 852 higher secondary school teachers, where 77% teachers are female and 33% teachers are male. Chart 2 and Table 5 show that, on the average, there are two teachers in one boys' Mosque school. There are three teachers in one boys' primary school whereas for each girls' primary school there are four teachers. Moreover, there are 11 teachers in one boys' middle school and 15 teachers in one girls' middle school. Likewise, there are 23 teachers in one boys' secondary school, 28 teachers in one girls' secondary school, 39 teachers in one boys' higher secondary school and 59 teachers in one girls' higher secondary school on the average.
